Q1. Introduction to Adobe Photoshop?

- Adobe Photoshop is a **professional image editing software** used for photo correction, retouching, digital painting, and graphic design.
 - It works with **pixels (raster graphics)**.

Q2. Define Magic Wand tool?

- A **selection tool** that selects areas of the same color with one click.
 - Useful for background removal.

Q3. Define Crop tool?

- Used to **trim, cut, or resize** an image.
 - Removes unwanted areas.

Q4. Define Spot Healing Brush tool?

- Automatically removes **blemishes, spots, and scratches** by blending with nearby pixels.

Q5. Define Patch tool?

- Repairs a selected area by **replacing it with pixels** from another part of the image.

Q6. Define Dodge tool?

- Lightens specific parts of an image.
 - Used for **highlighting**.

Q7. Define Zoom tool?

- Magnifies (zoom in) or reduces (zoom out) the view of an image.
-

Q8. Define Pixel?

- The **smallest unit of a digital image**.
 - Short for "Picture Element".
-

Q9. What is Layer?

- Layers are like **transparent sheets** stacked on each other.
 - Each layer can hold text, images, or effects separately.
-

Q10. What is Layer Panel?

- The **control center of layers** where you manage, hide/show, reorder, and apply effects to layers.

Q11. What is Adjustment Layer?

- A special layer used for **editing color, brightness, and contrast** without changing the original image.

- Moves the visible part of an image within the window when zoomed in.

Q1. What is Layers and why use Adobe Photoshop Layers?

- **Layers:** Separate transparent sheets where images, text, and effects are placed.
 - **Why use layers?**
 1. Easy editing without affecting the whole image.
 2. Allows non-destructive design.
 3. Manage multiple elements (text, shapes, images).
 4. Add blending, masks, and effects.

Q3. Describe Layers Panel in detail.

- The **Layers Panel** is where all layers are shown and managed.
- Features:

1. Shows thumbnails of each layer.
 2. Allows **renaming, deleting, grouping** layers.
 3. Supports **blending modes** (e.g., Multiply, Overlay).
 4. Controls **opacity and fill**.
 5. Provides **layer styles** (shadows, glows, strokes).
 6. Contains **adjustment and mask options**.

Q4. What is Pixel?

- Pixel = Picture Element.
 - Smallest unit of a digital image that holds color information.
 - Resolution depends on the number of pixels (e.g., 1920×1080).
 - More pixels = higher clarity.
