

Chapter 3 – Adobe Photoshop**Part I: Short Questions****Q1. Define Magic Wand Tool?**

- A selection tool used to **select areas of similar color** in an image with one click.
 - Tolerance value controls the range of colors selected.
-

Q2. Define Polygonal Lasso Tool?

- A selection tool used to draw **straight-edged selections** by clicking points around the object.
 - Best for selecting objects with straight lines.
-

Q3. Define Pen Tool?

- A **path-creating tool** used to draw shapes, curves, and precise selections.
 - Commonly used for cutouts and vector paths.
-

Q4. How to change colour with edit in Quick Mask Tool?

- Enter **Quick Mask Mode (Q key)**.
 - Paint over the area with **Brush Tool**.
 - Exit Quick Mask → selection is created.
 - Apply new **Fill or Adjustment** to change color.
-

Q5. How to apply shining effect on a picture in Adobe Photoshop?

- Use **Lens Flare Filter** from Filter > Render > Lens Flare.
 - Or apply **Outer Glow/Highlight** in Layer Styles.
-

Q6. How to apply brightening effect in Adobe Photoshop?

- Use **Image > Adjustments > Brightness/Contrast**.
 - Or apply an **Adjustment Layer (Brightness/Exposure/Levels)**.
-

Q7. What is Photo Retouching?

- The process of **improving an image** by removing imperfections (spots, wrinkles, dust, scratches).
 - Tools: Healing Brush, Clone Stamp, Patch Tool.
-

Q8. Define Tolerance?

- A setting in tools like Magic Wand that **controls the range of colors** selected.
 - Higher tolerance = wider range, Lower tolerance = more precise.
-

Q9. How to remove glow from parts of image?

- Use **Eraser Tool** or **Layer Mask** to hide glow.
 - Alternatively, reduce glow using **Smudge/Blur Tool**.
-

Q10. What is Sharpening in Photo Retouching?

- A technique to **enhance edges and details** in an image.
 - Done using **Filter > Sharpen > Unsharp Mask/Smart Sharpen**.

✔ Part II: Long Questions**Q1. Describe Pen Tool in detail.**

- Used for **drawing paths** and making precise selections.
 - Types:
 - Path selection
 - Shape creation
 - Curved paths using anchor points
 - Common Uses:
 - Background removal
 - Creating custom shapes
 - Making smooth curves

Q2. How to change colours with Edit in Quick Mask Mode?

1. Enter Quick Mask (press **Q**).
 2. Select Brush Tool → paint area (red overlay).
 3. Exit Quick Mask → painted part becomes selection.
 4. Apply **Fill or Adjustment Layer** to change color.
-

Q3. Write the method of Photo Retouching in Photoshop.

- Open image in Photoshop.
 - Use tools:
 1. **Healing Brush** → removes spots.
 2. **Patch Tool** → repairs large areas.
 3. **Clone Stamp** → copies pixels.
 4. **Dodge/Burn Tool** → lightens/darkens parts.
 - Final step → apply **Sharpening** to enhance image.

Q4. Describe Magic Wand Tool of Photoshop.

- **Definition:** Selects pixels of similar color.
- **Steps:**
 1. Choose Magic Wand Tool.
 2. Click on area → Photoshop selects based on tolerance.
 3. Modify selection using Add/Remove options.
- **Uses:**
 - Background removal.
 - Selecting sky, solid colors, or flat backgrounds.

Q1. Difference between Lasso Tool and Pen Tool?

- Lasso: Freehand selection, less accurate.
- Pen: Path-based, more precise.

Q2. What is the difference between Clone Stamp and Healing Brush?

- Clone Stamp: Copies exact pixels.
- Healing Brush: Blends copied pixels with surroundings.

Q3. What are Filters in Photoshop?

- Predefined effects used to modify images (e.g., Blur, Sharpen, Distort).

Q4. What is the difference between Brightness and Exposure?

- Brightness: Adjusts lightness/darkness of entire image.
- Exposure: Specifically adjusts light captured in highlights/shadows.
